Thank you for your interest in volunteering with New Life Furniture Bank! Here is an outline of the programs that we offer:

Organizing Household Goods: Every furniture delivery also includes household items like dishes, cookware and linens - essential items that are important to help our neighbors in need as they settle into their new homes. Work with us in our Community Engagement Center by sorting and packing donated household items for delivery. Morning or afternoon shifts are available Tuesday-Friday and Saturdays by appointment. Assisting with Client Deliveries: Follow along with our trucks and assist in delivering furniture and household goods. See firsthand how our organization is committed to "doing good" by serving our most vulnerable neighbors. When we deliver furniture, we turn empty houses into homes thereby giving people hope and dignity. Shifts are available Tuesday-Friday between 9AM-12PM. Assisting in our Thrift Store: In 2022 we opened a Thrift Store to sell donated items that we cannot use for delivery to our clients, such as artwork, toys, books, clothing, accessories and much more. We receive new treasures daily! The proceeds from store sales are used to further our mission. We need volunteers for a variety of tasks, including accepting, sorting, pricing, and stocking donations, setting up and tidying merchandise displays, and sorting recyclable items. Late morning, mid afternoon and early evening shifts are available Tuesday-Friday and afternoon shifts are available Saturday and Sunday. <u>Table Builds/Painting:</u> We work closely with members of the Cincinnati Woodworking Club to supplement our furniture donations by building coffee, end, and dining tables. You are welcome to join our public furniture builds to help. No experience is necessary! The hours are 9AM-12PM on alternate Mondays, Thursdays, or Saturdays. Please note that we have a capacity of 12 volunteers per shift for this program and it is open to ages 12 years and up. Once the tables are constructed, we need 3 or 4 volunteers to apply the final touch: a fresh coat of paint to give the tables a more finished appearance. **LOCATION: NEW LIFE FURNITURE BANK WAREHOUSE-11335 REED HARTMAN HWY #134, BLUE ASH, OH 45241**

Buy-and-Build Furniture Assembly: This is a new program being rolled out in the summer of 2024. We will schedule teams to assemble flat pack dressers in our Community Center for delivery to our clients. Volunteers will make a donation to cover the purchase of the dressers prior to the event. We will provide necessary tools for assembly. Teams of 2 can assemble a dresser in approximately 1 ½ to 2 hours. A minimum of 3 weeks notice is required to schedule this event.
